PAPALIN

Papalin is a new project dedicated to blended rum which aims to add new life into an old, established category. As a "tropical dependent bottler," Velier creates direct partnerships with distilleries for both sourcing and aging rums – depending on the distilleries themselves and their know-how for rum production and skill of aging which takes place entirely in the aging warehouse of the distilleries. This way, Papalin is produced hand in hand with distillery partners as a collaborative effort and showcases a new vision in the world of rum.

This Papalin is a blend of three Jamaican rums, composed of Worthy Park *WPL* that has an ester range of 60-119 gr/hlPA, a Long Pond *STCE* with an ester rate of 550 to 700 gr/hlPA, and a Hampden C <> H with an ester content of 1,300-1,400 gr/hlPA.

This new Papalin was distilled in pot still and aged for 5 years in the tropical climate of Jamaica. Bottled at 57% ABV with no adulteration, this version is filled with medicinal and mineral notes that brilliantly stamp the Jamaica hallmark on its palette of flavours and aromas.

TASTING NOTES

Nose: Full and unctuous. The aroma palette is both tangy and smooth, revealing a subtle combination of vanilla, lemon, cane sugar, mint and fresh walnut. Allowed to breathe, sweet spices like ginger and cinnamon, overripe banana and heady florals come through with energy.

Palate: Well-balanced and smooth. Like the nose, the flavor palate opens with vanilla and lemon. Herbal infusions like rosemary, vervain seep deeply into the taste buds. This fresh sequence is drawn out by more tropical notes of fresh pineapple and banana.

Finish: Long and silky. A delicious lime tart guides us into an abundantly rich finish. With time, rich rosewood notes emerge alongside herbaceous coriander.

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
